The law does say that the STO must consider financial need.</p> 	<p>Students eligible: Those meeting any one of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attended an AZ public or charter school as a full-time student for at least 90 days, or one full semester, of the prior school year • In Kindergarten at a qualified AZ private school • In a preschool program for students with disabilities at a qualified AZ private school (ages 3 & up) • A dependent of a member of the U.S. Armed Forces who is stationed in AZ pursuant to military orders • Received a scholarship in any previous year from the Overflow Program, the Low-Income Corporate Program or the Disabled/Displaced Corporate Program AND has continued to attend a qualified AZ private school 	<p>Students eligible: Those whose family income does not exceed 185% of the income required to qualify a child for reduced price lunches AND who meet any one the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attended an AZ public or charter school as a full-time student for at least 90 days, or one full semester, of the prior school year • In Kindergarten at a qualified AZ private school • In a preschool program for students with disabilities at a qualified AZ private school (ages 3 & up) • A dependent of a member of the U.S. Armed Forces who is stationed in AZ pursuant to military orders • Received a scholarship in any previous year from the Original Program, the Overflow Program or the Low-Income Corporate Program AND has continued to attend a qualified AZ private school 	<p>Students eligible: Those who have an IEP, MET or 504 plan from an AZ public or charter school (current or expired)</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Those who have been in the AZ foster care system at some point</p>
